The winter temperatures have arrived! Please remember to send your child to school with outside weather gear - a warm coat, hat, scarf, gloves, and boots, when the snow starts to accumulate. The children are outside before school starts in the morning when the temperature and/or wind chill is 20 degrees or higher. For the morning and afternoon recesses, they go outside if the temp/wind chill is 15 degrees or above. So please - send that cold weather gear - and label items with your child's name! Honesty

Our character trait at RGS for January is Honesty. The daily pledge that we recite together is, "I will be honest by telling the truth and admitting my mistakes." Students will watch Auto Be Good to introduce the traits each month. Being honest shows that you are a person who is also respectful, responsible and caring. You show you are honest when you tell the truth, keep your promises, and act respectfully. We remind children that playing by the rules, not cheating, and admitting when one makes a mistake are also ways to show you are an honest person.

Some things parents and siblings can do at home to help your children be honest:

Read a book and talk about how the characters in that book showed honesty or the other character traits we've covered this year (respect, responsibility, caring).

Catch them being honest. Expressing your approval is a powerful way to reinforce honest behaviors in your children.

Model the kind of honest behavior you want your child to adopt. You are your child's most powerful teacher.
