### Dear prospective Cub Scout parents:

In Cub Scouts your son will have lots of fun, learn new things, and make new friends. But Cub Scouts is much more than that – it is fun...with a purpose!

Since 1910, the Boy Scouts of America has helped younger boys through Cub Scouting. It is a year-round family program designed for boys who are in the first through fifth grade (or 6 through 11 years old). Parents, leaders, and organizations work together to achieve the purposes of Cub Scouting. A boy must have completed kindergarten in order to join in Cub Scout activities, but you can sign up now and be part of our Pack meetings and learn about our summer activities. If your son is starting first grade in the fall, you can sign up now and participate in all the summer activities! It's easy to join: simply fill out an application and submit it with the \$24 (only \$12 for ½ a year of scouting) yearly registration fee at the Pack meeting!
